RENEWAL AGREEMENT FOR REFUSE REMOVAL SERVICE CONTRACT

THIS RENEWAL AGREEMENT (the "Renewal Agreement") is entered into effective as of the day of July, 2017 (the "Effective Date") by and between the the <u>City of Canal Fulton, Ohio</u> ("City") and <u>Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC</u> dba Republic Services Massillon Division ("Operator") (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City and Operator are parties to that certain Collection and Transportation Agreement dated July 19th, 2012 (the "Contract") for collection and disposal of municipal solid waste and collection and processing of recyclable materials in the City, expiring on September 30th, 2017, attached hereto and made a part hereof as "EXHIBIT "A", and;

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the Contract for collection and disposal of municipal solid waste and processing of recyclable materials for an additional term of one (1) year;

WHEREAS, in accordance with said agreement, and the City Manager is hereby authorized by the City Council to enter into an extension agreement with the "Operator", to provide for the collection and disposal of municipal solid waste and processing of recyclable materials for an additional term of one (1) to three (3) years, in accordance with the proposal submitted, specifications and bidding instructions.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and other good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

- Renewal: The parties agree that the Contract is renewed for a new term effective as of the Effective Date, and modified as provided for in this Renewal Agreement, for an additional one (1) year term beginning October 1, 2017 and terminating September 30th, 2018 (the "Renewal Term").
- 2. Rates: Beginning on October 1st, 2017, the rates for services provided under the Contract shall be as provided in "EXHIBIT "B",
- 3. <u>Modification to Rates</u>: The parties shall discuss and agree to, any future extensions, or, and adjustments in rates for unforeseen government regulatory changes and fuel rate increases over \$3.00 per gallon at least 45 days prior to and adjustments taking place.
- 4. Other Provisions: Except as specifically modified in this Renewal Agreement, all other provisions of the Contract (as amended and updated) shall remain in full force and effect.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Canal Fulton wishes to establish a natural gas aggregation program pursuant to Section 4929.26, Ohio Revised Code (the "Natural Gas Program"), for the residents, businesses and other consumers located within the City, and for that purpose, to act jointly with any other City, village, township, municipal corporation, county or other political subdivision of the State of Ohio, as permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, by joining the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council, the City will be able to act jointly with other member political subdivisions and thereby maximize the potential benefit of natural gas deregulation through group purchasing efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANAL FULTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City (the "Council") finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City, including the natural gas consumers located within the City, to join and to adopt the NOPEC Bylaws, for the purpose of establishing and implementing the Natural Gas Program within the City.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement Establishing the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (the "NOPEC Agreement"). The NOPEC Agreement shall be substantially in the form presented to this Council and on file with the Clerk, subject to such changes, insertions and omissions which are consistent with this Resolution and are not substantially adverse to the City and as may be approved by the Mayor of the City, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the NOPEC Agreement.

SECTION 3. The Council hereby approves and adopts the Bylaws of NOPEC (in the form attached to the NOPEC Agreement).

- a. <u>Street Maintenance</u>. Emergency repairs, routine maintenance, snow and ice control, and street cleaning on all public streets and roads. Where any road is divided in the Annexation area, the City of Canal Fulton agrees to be responsible for repairs, routine maintenance, snow and ice removal, and street cleaning on the entire roadway.
- b. <u>Street Lighting.</u> Street lights may be installed by petition of property owner.
- c. Water Installation Costs. Water main extensions may be installed by property owner and, subject to approval by the Director of Public Service, the city shall provide free of charge all piping necessary to extend water mains to new residential, commercial or industrial development with the city. The property owner shall be responsible for preparation of plans and installation of the water main extension in compliance with city Water Department specifications and city Code requirements, including obtaining applicable permits and subject to city inspection and approval. Upon installation, the city shall be the owner of the water main and shall thereafter maintain the same, subject to the requirement that the property owner or developer shall maintain the water main for one year at his/her sole cost and expense. The property owner and/or developer shall execute such contracts as are required by the Water Department. This section shall not be interpreted to include the provision of materials of tap-ins to existing water mains, which are the property owner's responsibility and expense.
- d. Street Costs. Streets may be installed by property owner in compliance with regulations of the City of Canal Fulton, Ohio.
